The escalation of domestic violence to a highly dangerous/potentially lethal level follows a pattern with identifiable indicators. If it is identifiable, it is predictable. This training will provide an instructional guide for batterer intervention and prevention programs, advocates, prosecutors, and law enforcement officers to ensure safety and to determine indicators for highly dangerous/potentially lethal behaviors: to include strangulation, provider and victim safety and perpetrator accountability.
