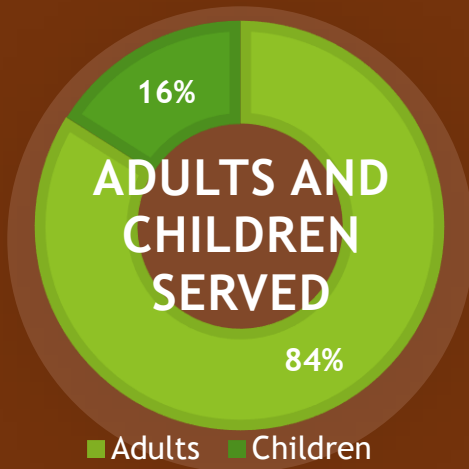


Domestic Violence Services in West Virginia

Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Statistical Report

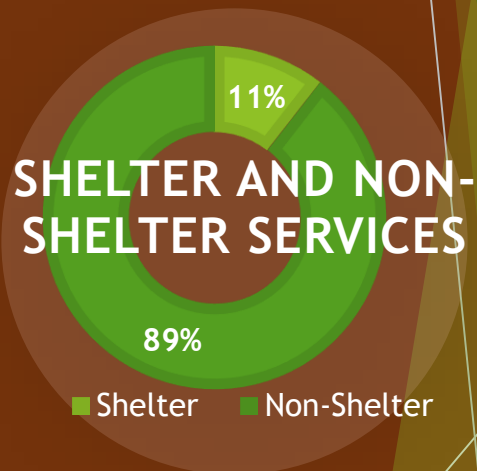
SERVICES PROVIDED
